## Rules

### **Duties and responsibilities of the Assistant Coach**

#### Game days:

One or Two days prior to game day he/she is to phone all players to see if they will be attending the game, (or delegate a parent) and is to report to the Head Coach allowing him to set the team positions. He/she should impress on the player after the second consecutive absentee as a team player he should be at the next game, unless for a long illness or fracture. If the player due to sickness or other reasons game day. He or she is to phone 1 1/2 hours or sooner to the Assistant or Head Coach, He/She is to help the coach with drills during practices.

On game day the Assistant Coach is required to fill out or verify the score sheet making sure that all players names and numbers are correct. He/She during games readies the next shift to go on so that there is a minimum time delay between shifts.

Also the Assistant Coach should recruit a person as timekeeper.

- All coaches are subject to police check by the league. All information is kept confidential.

The Assistant Coach will assume the roll of the Head Coach during his/her absence.

#### Assistant Coaches other duties:

In Novice and Mini levels he/she should make sure that all players are wearing their kneepads.

The Assistant Coach is to check and collect any and hold any watches or jewelry during a game or practice.

The Assistant Coach is to be the liaison between the coach and the parent. He /She will report to the Head Coach any concerns the parents may have. He/She will also distribute schedules and announce any changes to (game or practice) schedule.
